Greetings from All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE)!

As you are aware that AICTE has decided that from this year Additional Courses (New Courses) and increase in intake in Engineering and Technology shall be granted only in the Emerging Areas. As per Approval Process Handbook (APH) 2020-21 in the emerging areas one of the courses B.Tech Artificial Intelligence and Data Science which can be offered as a degree course in Engineering and apart from that the Minor & Hons courses can be given as per AICTE emerging area list APH clause 7.3.2 (e) from the A.Y.2020-21.


It has also been requested that if any University wants to open any other course that can be considered as the emerging area may submit the syllabus as per clause 7.3.1.

In view of the above, You may send the proposal for new courses in Emerging Areas with due endorsement by the Registrar/ Director of affiliating University/ Board/ Technical Institution with detailed Syllabus and Curriculum and its nomenclature to the Adviser I, Policy and Academic Planning Bureau, AICTE before 30th September 2020 to include the same in the APH 2021-22. 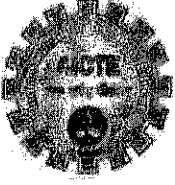

Sir,

As you are aware that AICTE had constituted a Committee to formulate the National Perspective Plan (NPP) under the Chairmanship of Shri BVR Mohan Reddy. As per National Perspective, the AICTE has decided that from this year Additional Courses and increase in intake in Engineering and Technology shall be granted only in the Emerging Areas viz., Artificial Intelligence (AI), Internet of Things (IoT), Blockchain, Robotics, Quantum Computing, Data Sciences, Cyber Security, 3D Printing and Design, Augmented Reality / Virtual Reality (AR/VR), as specified in Annexure 1 of the Approval Process Handbook.

2. As per APH 2020-21 in the emerging areas one of the courses B.Tech Artificial Intelligence and Data Science which can be offered as degree course in Engineering and apart from that the Major & Minor courses can be given as per AICTE emerging area list APH clause 7.3.2 (e) from the A.Y. 2020-21.

3. Further, it is also requested that if any University wants to open any other course that can be considered as **emerging area** may submit the syllabus as per clause 7.3.1 which reads as "Provided that, if any Institution proposes to start a new Course whose nomenclature is not available in Appendix 2 of the Approval Process Handbook, prior concurrence, as the case may be, by the Council for the same shall be necessary. For such concurrence, the Institution with due endorsement by the Registrar/ Director of affiliating University/ Board/ Technical Institution shall submit detailed Syllabus and Curriculum and its nomenclature to the Policy and Academic Planning Bureau, AICTE before 30th September of the Calendar Year, to process the same in the respective Board".

4. in view of the above, All the AICTE Approved Institutes / Universities may send the proposed list of Emerging Areas with due endorsement by the Registrar / Director of affiliating University / Board / Technical Institution with detailed Syllabus and Curriculum and its nomenclature to the Policy and Academic Planning Bureau, AICTE before 30th September to include the same in the APH 2021-22.
